“Boobie Rock” would be a bar with prurient content at 10855 W IH-10, south of Huebner. If Cibrian’s October Temporary Restraining Order (based on deed restrictions) is lifted by the court, our next fight will probably be before an administrative judge concerning its liquor license.

If we don’t stop “Boobie Rock”, other businesses with sexual content will target I-10.

Off-Premise Digital Signs

The outdoor sign lobby, aka Clear Channel, wants to convert off-premise passive signs (aka “billboards”) to Digital (LED) technology. The current draft (F) of the ordinance is bad for San Antonio: **Negates the freeze** on billboard construction on Wurzbach Parkway, I-10, 1604, 151 and other highways, as ‘Scenic and Urban Corridors’; **Does not give setbacks** to neighborhoods for noise and light abatement; **Has unknown safety risks** - no national, independent study on Digital Signs; and **Sells out** city beauty and citizen interests - a trade of 4 old signs for 1 new Digital sign is unacceptably low.

We can expect high traffic corridors such as I-10, 1604 and Wurzbach Prkwy to be targeted for Digital Signs.
