

Review of Yogi Bear's Jellystone Park, Texas

Located in the Hill Country of Texas near Canyon Lake is a fun little campground called Yogi Bear's Jellystone Park. It has become one of my kid's favorites because of the family friendly atmosphere and how the hosts go the extra mile for your children's entertainment.



The campground is located on the south side of FM306 as you near Canyon Lake. The facilities are very nice with a great number of full hook-up camping sites, cabins, an indoor and outdoor pool, Jacuzzi and camp store. It's the additional things they provide for kids that truly makes them special. They have pedal carts to rent, volleyball and basketball courts, a game room doubling as a movie room running classic cartoons, a hayride, pancake breakfasts and Yogi the Bear to meet with the kids for photos. Recently added is a large inflated "jumping pillow" (think trampoline combined with a jumping castle) on which the kids can burn off some energy. My kids, and most of the other kids, spent hours running and jumping on this favorite attraction.



The camping sites in general are nice but not overly roomy. Most of the front side sites are located among the trees but they have another section towards the back and across the dry creek bed (area B) where there are very few trees and the sites press closer together.

They have a number of tenting sites mainly along the grassy area near the creek. The shower and restroom facilities are comfortable and the whole park is kept very clean. The campground is quite popular most weekends during the summer months but we were usually able to get reservations without too much difficulty. Outside the park, but in the local area, are of course Canyon Lake and a variety of Tubing vendors to help keep you cool.

Though I prefer a bit more room between campsites my kids often ask “When are we going to Yogi’s!” I can especially recommend the park for those with younger children though I saw a large number of teenagers having a pretty good time there this summer!

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
