

Review of Lake Corpus Christi KOA, Texas

Lake Corpus Christi is located about two-thirds of the way from San Antonio to Corpus Christi along I-37. Along the Eastern banks of the lake is a nice KOA campsite that includes lake access.

Their tent camping is along the grassy banks of the lake. This section of the lake near the KOA contains a lot of stumps and trees but that makes it a fisherman's paradise. Many of the boats coming back to dock were carrying loads of catfish. The lake was very low while I was there, and given the drought during the last few years, I'd expect that the condition has continued.

The RV sites, as with all KOAs, are more closely spaced than I prefer. With the RV sites so close together, your awning may shade your neighbors also. Amenities include a pool, playground and camp store. If you don't like trains or train noise this may not be a good campsite for you as they have railroad tracks right outside the campground.

One other oddity about the site is that the restrooms and shower facilities are combined into one small building with three rooms, each containing a toilet and shower. While it felt nice to have your own little bathroom like at home it had the unfortunate result of locking everyone out of the bathrooms after the first three people decided to shower. In fact it was after this trip that my wife and I upgraded from a pop-up to a trailer so that wouldn't happen again.

If you need a nice little campsite either at the Lake or within driving distance of the coast, this fills the bill, but personally, I'd rather continue down to one of the campsites along the beach.
