

Rock Creek Project Update

In January, representatives from the Bexar County Flood Control Program will meet again with association members and residents who live along Rock Creek to discuss the Rock Creek NWWC/Outfall (SA6) flood control project, which is intended to improve drainage conditions and stabilize the sides of the creek. Bexar County is funding the project through its 10-year, \$500 million Regional Flood Control Program.

To maintain the natural channel aesthetics, the Preliminary Engineering Study recommended solutions including new landscaping, such as brush and plants, moving and reshaping the channel, and adding soil retention structures such as strategically placed rocks or small block walls that will help stabilize the channel banks. Bexar County is currently in the Detailed Design Phase to prepare the drawings. These will be advertised for bid in September 2011, and construction will begin thereafter.

A meeting and walkabout for residents along the creek will be held at Saint Andrew Presbyterian Church on January 29 at 10:00 a.m. in the All Saints Hall. Representatives will also attend the VJNA Annual Meeting on January 26.
