

## **Bexar County Presents Flood Control Project Update**

Bexar County Flood Control Division Manager Art Villarreal was a guest speaker at the VJNA Annual Meeting on January 26.

Art gave an overview of the Bexar County Flood Control Program, which is a 10-year, \$500 million capital improvement program that is funding regional flood control improvements across Bexar County and, for the first time, inside city limits. The program was funded by Bexar County Commissioners Court in 2007.

Included in the first phase of projects is the Rock Creek NWWC/Outfall (SA 6) flood control project that falls within the limits of the Vance Jackson Neighborhood. Art explained that Bexar County had been out meeting with the VJNA Board of Directors and with property owners along Rock Creek since late 2008 and that the project was now in the Detailed Design Phase. He invited VJNA members to attend a community meeting that would be held the following Saturday morning at Saint Andrew Presbyterian Church to learn more about the project. Bexar County officials report that about 40 people attended the Saturday morning meeting.
