Arturo Villarreal, Jr., P.E., C.F.M., is the Flood Control Division Manager within the Bexar County Infrastructure Services Department.

He is responsible for the development and administration of Bexar County's 10-year, \$500 million watershed management program, which funds flood control capital improvement projects across Bexar County.

In addition to being one of the largest capital improvement programs in the county's history, this program also marks the first time the county will address flood control challenges inside the limits of San Antonio and other suburban cities.

Arturo was born and raised in San Antonio. He is a registered Professional Engineer and Certified Floodplain Manager and received his B.S. in Engineering and Master of Business Administration.
