We would like to add our protest to the street closure by Red McCombs. Sugar Hill Apartments has 276 residents and with visitors and vendors, there are approximately 294 people that would be affected in some respect by this attempted closure of Mockingbird. Needless to say this count is even greater when the tenants and visitors of Greatview Office Building are added.

I cannot understand how the closure would 'eliminate a hazardous cut-through to the access road' when another McCombs Pontiac dealership on Loop 410 operates on both sides of a street that, it appears, his customers and employees need to cross in order to access both sides of his business.

The bigger hazards are his placing vehicles on the grass area between his property line and access road with giant inflatable animals such as the most recent one (a gorilla) that blocks your view, and his customers and others parking in the red zone at the fire hydrant.

I have met the Greatview Building owner representative Frank Buhler on 9/17/08 and they are also opposed to the closure.
