Thanks so much for the email and thank your wife for calling me this morning to follow up! After MUCH digging I was able to have the Sergeants pull the case for me. Since quite a bit of it is not public record yet I can only pass along that one adult was arrested along with two juveniles for several crimes which included vandalism and assault (throwing rocks and hitting a pedestrian). All 3 were taken to jail and the juveniles admitted that the step -father had been taking them out on these excursions since December. The case number for all of the incidents yesterday is SAPD11039417....This will be passed on to property crimes detectives since it contains suspect information pertaining to similar crimes which have occurred recently in both areas.

To the group, thanks so much everyone for being so alert!..it took 5 calls to put together enough information to get the plate # on this suspect vehicle which led us to the actors. Someone was able to get the first 3 digits and 2 other persons were able to get the last along with a good description of the actors and vehicle involved. GREAT JOB!!

I also have to commend the evening shift officers, there were about 6 involved in the apprehension and they were outstanding!
