Subject: Burglary Apprehensions

Wow! It's been a busy, busy week! Our B-shift SAFFE and patrol officers picked up 2 more burglars hitting homes just the other side of Wurzbach from you guys and took them into Property Crimes for follow up. They will be checking other cases to see if these guys were involved in any of them as well. Myself and A-shift made a GREAT apprehension the following morning for one of my car thieves that has been hitting in the morning. He stole an SUV off of Ironside and Colony and was picked up within 20 minutes still driving it. We arrested him for the vehicle theft and were able to have him listed as a suspect in several other thefts.

Just to follow up with everyone, those of you who sent me emails regarding the female burglar, I forwarded those over to property crimes to go back and research the cases. If I hear anything I will definitely pass it along.

Also just a note to everyone, if anyone knocks at your door and you answer, then they give you some lame excuse like they are looking for lawn work, but they have not lawn equipment with them, please try and get a license plate.

These guys will not contact someone standing in their yard. Remember they are looking for homes that are unoccupied so they do "test" knocks. Usually when you answer they are not expecting it and they make up something like they are looking for someone and have the wrong address, or they are lawn maintenance/tree trimmers. I will try and send out an email with some suspect vehicle descriptions this afternoon (hopefully). I have a meeting downtown with our DART team and then an event with our Chief afterwards so it may not be until tomorrow.
