**Mayor Julian Castro and Texas State Demographer Lloyd Potter Ph. D. to Speak on SA 2020 Report and 2010 Census at Neighborhood Conference**

The Neighborhood Resource Center, a non-profit organization, is pleased to welcome San Antonio Mayor Julian Castro and Texas State Demographer, Lloyd Potter Ph.D. to discuss and inform residents about the SA2020 Vision project and the 2010 Census statistics, and what they mean to San Antonio neighborhoods at its Annual Neighborhood Conference to be held on June 11, 2011 from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the Laurel Heights United Methodist Church.

As recently-released U.S. Census Bureau data has confirmed, the San Antonio area is changing, growing in population and shifting in density by area. These changes have major implications for area neighborhoods from adjustments in traffic patterns, to neighborhood businesses, to strains placed on city and county services and infrastructure. Keeping up with these changes is necessary so that we are not swept away by them.
